The NSPCC (National Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children) this free, pre-recorded workshop for parents/carers will cover vital key topics that affect many young people today, including:

- Online bullying and how to help your child deal with it
- Mental health and the impact of the digital world
- Social media and its potential risks and benefits

The 40-minute presentation also provides useful resources and signposts organisations where you can seek further help and support so you know ways you can help keep your children safe online.
