Dear Y5 parents and carers,

You have recently received a letter regarding the residential, this is when your child will be in Y6. We acknowledge that this is a costly time for many families. Miss Goldsmith has worked hard to secure funding for the residential. As the cost of activities and travel are forever increasing Y5 will be fundraising to raise money to pay towards the coach cost. If you have any ideas or would like to support your child in fundraising, please let me know.

A trip has been arranged for Year 5 to visit The Pettypool Outdoor Centre in Northwich on Tuesday 4th June. We will be travelling by coach which will leave around 9.05am for the day to start at 10am and we should be back at school by **4pm**. This visit is arranged for the summer term, and it is an exciting day of outdoor activities which will be beneficial and rewarding.

Whilst there, the children will be taking part in an outdoor program of team building activities including high ropes, archery and orienteering. All of the sessions will be led by a fully trained member of Pettypool staff.

Your child will require old trainers or similar and appropriate clothing as they will be outside all day. Old clothes you don't mind potentially getting muddy will be just fine! Please ensure trousers, leggings, tracksuit bottoms are worn even if it is very sunny. Weather appropriate belongings may be needed for your child such as a sun hat and sun cream if the weather is glorious. (Fingers crossed).

As we will be there for the day your child will require a packed lunch. This can be provided from school. See the attached form for details.

The cost of this visit is **£30.00**. Payments can be made in full or partial payments on School Comms. We would require a deposit of £5.00 on or before Friday 19th April. This balance is required to be paid in full on or before Friday 26th May 2023.

Attached is the medical/consent form provided by Pettypool. This must be completed for your child to take part. Please read it carefully, sign and return to school by Wednesday 27th March. These forms will be sent to them prior to the visit.

A reminder please let myself or one of the Y5 team know if your child suffers from travel sickness/hay fever etc so the appropriate measures can be taken before this visit takes place.
