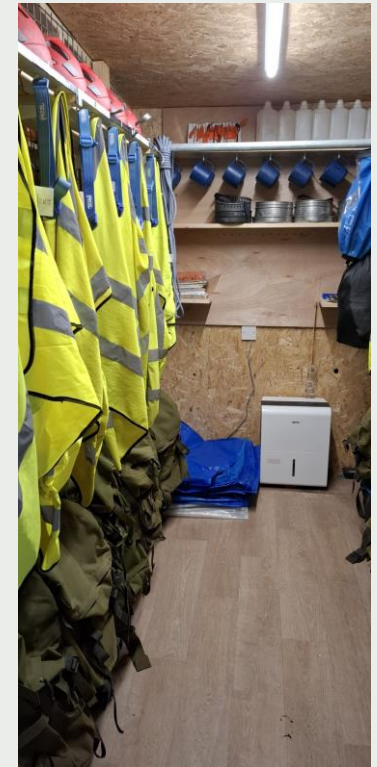
We are that busy visiting different places that you won't even miss them anyway!
